Dear Colleagues,

I am writing on behalf of the Commission of Inquiry on Lebanon, established by the Human Rights Council pursuant to its resolution S-2/1 adopted on 11 August 2006 during its second special session.

On 1 September, the President of the Human Rights Council appointed the following members of the Commission:

Mr. João Clemente Baena Soares (Brazil)
Mr. Stelios Perrakis (Greece)
Mr. Mohamed Chande Othman (Tanzania)

The Commission is an independent body and is supported by a Secretariat of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights.

Paragraph 7 of resolution S-2/1 of the Human Rights Council requests the Commission:

- “(a) to investigate the systematic targeting and killings of civilians by Israel in Lebanon;
(b) to examine the types of weapons used by Israel and their conformity with international law;
and
(c) to assess the extent and deadly impact of Israeli attacks on human life, property, critical infrastructure and the environment.”
