I am writing in response to your letter of January 17th, 2007 regarding the unofficial Holocaust conference that was held in Cairo Dec. 27th, 2007 by the Arab Socialist Party. I have considered your comments with the appropriate seriousness and have conveyed them to Cairo.

I am confident that you are both well aware of Egypt's pioneering role in the pursuit of a comprehensive Arab Israeli peace. Consequently, you should feel confident that it is neither the Egyptian government's policy, nor is it in Egypt's national interest to engage in, or even encourage, revisionist history or appear insensitive to the concerns and beliefs of other peoples.

As we start a new year, just weeks after all the Abrahamic faiths celebrated religious holidays, I hope we will be able to work together for better understanding and tolerance, and the mutual benefit of the American and Egyptian people.
