Your Excellency,

The International Association of Jewish Lawyers and Jurists (IAJLJ) has learned that recently antisemitic posters have been published in Hungary. A copy of one such poster is attached to this letter for your review.

Although antisemitism is a heinous phenomenon that continues to take place world-wide, this troubling picture reminds us of the propaganda leveled against Jews before War World Two. It is unfortunate that this notorious occurrence continues to be seen to this day.

The IAJLJ recognizes that in 2010 Hungary enacted a law making Holocaust denial an offence and we therefore accept that the government of Hungary acknowledges the importance of eradicating antisemitic activities. Accordingly, the IAJLJ asks that the Hungarian Government consider enacting further legislation that would prevent and criminalize other manifestations of antisemitism in Hungary, for example, publications of the type referred to here.

As Hungary is a country that defends human rights and is a part of the European Union, we hope that such measures will be taken before it is too late to effectively deal with the growing scourge of antisemitism.
